Kelantan BN to celebrate silver jubilee at home

KOTA BARU, Sun. - Barisan Nasional members and supporters in Kelantan unable to go to Kuala Lumpur for the coalition's silver jubilee celebrations on Oct 24 can still share the joy.

They can celebrate the event at the Yayasan Kemiskinan Kelantan complex at Padang Kala in Peringat.

A gathering to commemorate the event is being organised by the Kelantan Barisan Nasional for members and supporters on the same day as the one to be held in Kuala Lumpur at the Bukit Jalil stadium.

State Barisan Nasional chairman Datuk Annuar Musa said the celebration would begin at 6pm.

It will include a hajat prayer and a procession comprising some 20,000 members and supporters of the parties in the coalition.

The programme at the YKK complex would include a speech by State Umno liaison chief Tengku Razaleigh Hamzah.

"Barisan Nasional members and supporters at the celebration will also be able to hear Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's speech live over a giant-size screen at the venue," Annuar after launching a health camp for the Peringat parliamentary constituency at the Sekolah Menengah Kadok on Saturday.

Earlier, Annuar, who is also Rural Development Minister, advised leaders of the Opposition against exploiting issues to gain political mileage.

"Playing politics should not be at the expense of the people's interest," he said.

The Barisan Nasional Government kept politics out when dealing in matters pertaining to the people's interest and welfare.

He said the people of Kelantan continued to enjoy benefits, especially healthcare and educational facilities provided by the Federal Government, despite the State being under the Opposition.

They should be wise and not allow themselves to be hoodwinked by Pas antics, he added.
