LDP to urge Dr Mahathir to continue leading nation

KOTA KINABALU, Fri. - A resolution urging Prime Minister and Barisan Nasional chairman Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to continue leading Malaysia into the next millennium will be tabled at the Liberal Democratic Party's annual delegates conference on Sunday.

LDP president Datuk Chong Kah Kiat said it would be the only resolution at the low-key conference.

"I will table the resolution and I expect it to be unanimously passed by the delegates," he said today.

The conference will be attended by 700 delegates from its 20 divisions. LDP, a Chinese-based party, is one of the component members of the State BN.
