Ling praises Penang MCA reps

BUKIT MERTAJAM, Mon. - Satisfied with their performance, MCA president Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik will recommend to the Prime Minister that all Penang MCA MPs and assemblymen be retained in the coming general election.

"I am very, very happy with their performance ... More importantly, so are their constituents," he said. "As such, I will recommend to (Datuk Seri) Dr Mahathir Mohamad that all MCA people's representatives in Penang be retained in the general election."

Dr Ling, who is also Transport Minister, said this after opening the new RM8 million transportation depot of HRH Corporation (see CORRECTION above) in the Bukit Minyak industrial estate.

Also present were the company's chairman, Lee Choo Chiang, and its managing director, Lee Chin Heng.

Dr Ling said the two Penang MCA MPs and its nine assemblymen should be given another five years to "continue with their good work".

"They are so hardworking that one of them fell sick from dengue recently after participating in so many gotong royong," he said.

Dr Ling was referring to State Assemblyman for Kampong Kolam, Lim Gim Soon.

The two MCA MPs are Dr Tan Chong Keng (Bukit Mertajam) and Wong Kam Hong (Bayan Baru). Its eight other State assemblymen are Datuk Dr Sak Cheng Lum (Bagan Jermal), Datuk Koay Kar Huah (Bukit Gelugor), Dr Loh Hock Hun (Paya Terubong), Lee Hack Teik (Pengkalan Kota), Tan Cheng Liang (Jawi), Loo Ah Dee (Sungai Puyu), Lau Chiek Tuan (Berapit) and Lye Siew Weng (Air Itam).
