MALAYSIA AIRPORTS TO HOLD MOTORSPORTS EXHIBITION

SEPANG, Sept 7 (Bernama) -- Malaysia Airports Management and Technical Services Sdn Bhd, a subsidiary of Malaysia Airports Berhad, will hold an exhibition on motor and classic cars from Oct 2 to 24.

The International Motor and Classic Cars Show '99 will be held at the International Trade and Exhibition Centre (ITEC) in Subang inconjunction with Malaysia hosting the Petronas F1 Grand Prix from Oct 15 to 17.

Malaysia Airports chairman Tan Sri Basir Ismail said the exhibition was jointly held with Esparit Automobile Sdn Bhd, Europel Sdn. Bhd, TVR Sports Sdn Bhd, MSCVR (Malaysia-Singapore Classic and Vintage Car Registered), Porsche Club and Alpha Romeo.

"They have agreed to cooperate to make the exhibition the best motorsport show ever held in Malaysia," he said at the function to sign the agreement for holding the show, here today.

The show is Malaysia Airports' first attempt in organising a motorsport exhibition and it plans to hold similar events in the future.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad is expected to open the Motorsport Week held inconjunction with the Petronas F1 Grand Prix.

Among the highlights of the week are the Sepang 4x4 Challenge '99, Sepang Go-kart Championships '99 and Grand Prix Golf Tournament.
