MBS, CM visit Dr Mahathir at his home

Dr Mahathir, who is resting following his discharge from Institut Jantung Negara early this week, received a visit from the group of Menteris Besar and Chief Minister at his private residence in Sungai Besi in Kuala Lumpur yesterday.

The Prime Minister, who was with his wife Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasman Mohamed Ali, spent about an hour with them.

MBS and Chief Minister who were not present were Kelantan Menteri Besar Datuk Nik Abdul Aziz Nik Mat, Malacca Chief Minister Datuk Seri Abu Zahar Isnin and Kedah Menteri Besar Tan Sri Sanusi Junid.

Sarawak Chief Minister Tan Sri Abdul Taib Mahmud was represented by his deputy Tan Sri Alfred Jabu.

Also present were Dewan Rakyat Speaker Tun Mohamed Zahir Ismail and Dewan Negara president Tan Sri Mohamed Ya'acob.

Dr Mahathir was admitted to the IJN for lung infection on April 2 after his return from performing the haj in Mecca. He was discharged last Monday.

Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah of Brunei visited him on Wednesday while Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Ja'afar visited him earlier at IJN.

Although Dr Mahathir has fully recovered, he has been advised by doctors to continue resting at home before resuming his duties.
