MCA CONFIDENT VOTERS WILL GO FOR STABILITY

GOPENG, Nov 28 (Bernama) -- MCA has expressed confidence that the people will vote wisely tomorrow and support candidates from a party with a track record of bringing political stability and economic prosperity.

Its secretary-general Datuk Dr Ting Chew Peh said voters should vote the Barisan Nasional (BN) because it was capable of ensuring the country's continued prosperity and their children's future.

"Based on feedback received by the MCA, we are confident that Chinese voters will vote for Barisan Nasional candidates," he told reporters at the Gopeng MCA office today.

Dr Ting said his visits to Selangor, Kuala Lumpur, Perak, Pulau Pinang and Kedah showed that the majority of Chinese agreed with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's view that stability and prosperity were important to the country.

"I hope voters will make a wise decision," he said.

He said studies showed that MCA had more green (safe) seats than red (not so safe) ones.
