MCA MEMBERS AND MEDIA TOLD NOT TO SPREAD RUMOURS

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 16 (Bernama) -- MCA President Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik today urged party members and the media not to spread rumours to the effect that party Deputy President Datuk Lim Ah Lek is resigning.

"Do not be one of the rumour mongers," he told reporters at the MCA Chinese New Year open house at Wisma MCA, here.

He said this when asked to comment on speculation that Datuk Lim Ah Lek was about to resign his party post.

Dr Ling said the MCA leaders worked as a team to promote the party's interests.

Asked about the Barisan Nasional's chances in the next general election, Dr Ling said based on the present mood of the people they would support the BN because of its good track record.

Dr Ling said the success of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad in developing the country was one factor that the people took into consideration when supporting the government.

He was also confident that the country would be able to pull itself out of the economic crisis following measures taken by the administration.

"I believe this year of the Rabbit will be a good one and we will be able to get out of the economic problem," he said and urged the people to continue supporting the government.
