MCA DROPS TWO INCUMBENTS IN SELANGOR

PETALING JAYA, Nov 15 (Bernama) -- MP for Petaling Jaya Utara Vincent Lim and Kampung Tunku state assemblyman Khoo Ooi Seng are among the incumbents from the Selangor MCA to be dropped in the general election on Nov 29.

Selangor MCA treasurer Donald Lim Siang Chai said today two new faces, Chew Mei Fun and Dr Wong Sai Hou, would replace them as candidates.

Chew, the Wanita MCA national organising secretary, has been nominated to stand in Petaling Jaya Utara and Dr Wong, the PJ Utara MCA division chairman, in Kampung Tunku.

Speaking to reporters after the launch of the state-level Environment Week, here, he said the PJ Utara division's secretary, Lim Choon Kin would be nominated to contest the Damansara Utama state seat held by Dr Oon Hoon Geok of the DAP.

However, the state MCA had yet to decide on the candidates for the Serdang parliamentary and Balakong and Seri Kembangan state seats, he said.

It is rumoured that Serdang MP Yap Pian Hon, Balakong state assemblyman Hoh Hee Lee and Seri Kembangan state assemblyman Liew Yuan Keong will also be dropped this election.

Donald Lim said the other MCA incumbents in the state would be retained.

He said, however, that the candidates list was subject to confirmation by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad who is also the Barisan Nasional (BN) chairman.

The MCA had been allocated six parliamentary seats and 12 state seats to contest in Selangor, he added.
