MELAKA TO BRING MORE DEVELOPMENT TO TOWN AREAS

MELAKA, Dec 4 (Bernama) -- Development and tourism programmes in Melaka will be stepped up, said newly appointed Chief Minister Datuk Wira Mohamed Ali Rustam.

He said the Melaka state government is capable of bringing more development to town areas and the outskirts as well.

"Much more can be done in such areas and I am aware of the aspirations of the people and the problems they face," he said here today.

Mohamed Ali, the ninth Chief Minister of Melaka, earlier visited Radio Tiga Melaka, RTM, in Jalan Tun Seri Lanang here.
