MINDS BECOME TOPSY-TURVY AFTER READING SPECULATION ON CADIDATES- CM

JASIN, Nov 14 (Bernama) -- Melaka Chief Minister Datuk Seri Abu Zahar Isnin today urged the people not to heed press speculation or coffee shop talk on the likely BN candidates for the 10th General Election.

This speculation was only confusing the BN election preparation machinery, he said when launching a Computer Fund at a Tamil school in Merlimau here.

"Our minds become topsy-turvy when we read such speculation in the newspapers and believe in them," he said.

Several newspapers have speculated that Abu Zahar is among state leaders who would be "transferred".

Abu Zahar who is Melaka BN Chairman said he would meet Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad either tomorrow or Tuesday to get confirmation of the state BN candidates.

" Only then will the actual BN list be known," he said.

The important thing for the Melaka people is they should vote BN for continued political stability, peace and wellbeing, he added.
