Abdullah-Ministers

MINISTERS CANNOT HAVE BUSINESS INTERESTS

PUTRAJAYA, Dec 24 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad has reminded ministers that they cannot have business interests and should relinquish any post they hold in companies.

Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi said this was among the 13 aspects of responsibility and 14 points related to ethics for a minister as presented by Dr Mahathir at the new Cabinet's first meeting on Dec 15.

Abdullah said the Prime Minister told ministers that whenever discussions that might be related to their families cropped up they should excuse themselves from the meeting.

Dr Mahathir reiterated that ministers should be honest, sincere, diligent, efficient and open when discharging their duties.

"The Prime Minister also said they should be hands-on in their work," Abdullah told reporters after chairing a meeting of the Committee on Good Governance here today.

He said Dr Mahathir told them to fully understand what was contained in the Barisan Nasional (BN) manifesto for last month's general election.

Ministers were also told to better understand and work closely with their officers to ensure all programmes and Cabinet directives could be implemented speedily.

They should also identify and overcome bureaucratic procedures that were delaying the implementation of projects, Abdullah said.

"Ministers are responsible for taking follow-up actions to find out the actual status on implementation of directives conveyed to officers," he said.

This includes the level of implementation for projects under the ministries.

Ministers should also ensure that all officers have their own work procedure manual in order to perform their duties properly and speedily.

He said they were required to hold meetings with their officers to discuss all matters related to their ministries.

"Dr Mahathir also reminded them of their collective responsibility on whatever matter that is decided by the Cabinet," Abdullah said.
