MOHAMED SABU READY TO CONTEST OUTSIDE KELANTAN

KOTA BAHARU, Feb 9 (Bernama) -- Member of Parliament for Kubang Kerian Mohamed Sabu said today he is ready to contest in any constituency in the country as directed by the PAS leadership.

Mohamed, a two-term MP, said change of constituencies was not a problem as PAS candidates were capable of winning in any part of the country.

"I will abide by the party leadership's directive even if it means standing against Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad in Kubang Pasu," he told reporters here.

Two weeks ago, Kelantan Menteri Besar Kelantan Datuk Nik Abdul Aziz Nik Mat said Kelantanese were not parochial and hence candidates from outside of Kelantan including professionals and intellectuals would be standing on PAS tickets in the state in the next election.

Nik Aziz also said Mohamed Sabu, who is from Pulau Pinang, and the MP for Rantau Panjang Dr Sanusi Daeng Mariok from Johor were likely to be fielded outside of Kelantan.

Mohamed Sabu won the Kubang Kerian seat in 1995 with a majority of 10,125 votes against the BN candidate Mat Zin Awang.
