N SEMBILAN STATE EXCO TO BE FORMED BY NEXT WEEK

SEREMBAN, Dec 1 (Bernama) -- The Negeri Sembilan state executive council (Exco) will be formed by next week at the latest, said Menteri Besar Tan Sri Mohamed Isa Abdul Samad.

Mohamed Isa said he has yet to meet Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to discuss the appointment of State Exco members.

"As in the past, I would normally discuss the appointments especially concerning candidates from Umno with Dr Mahathir," he said here today.

Other component parties of the Barisan Nasional (BN) would send their list of proposed State Exco candidates to the Prime Minister and Mohamed Isa said he would be informed of it.

As to whether there will be new faces among the members of the State Exco, he said this would depend on his meeting with Dr Mahathir.

"I cannot say right now how many will be new faces," he said.

The previous State Exco has nine members.

In the just concluded 10th general election, the State BN made a clean sweep of the 32 state and seven parliamentary seats.

On party members who breached discipline and opposed BN candidates, Mohamed Isa said this had been orally reported to him.

"I have asked for a written report so that the matter can be investigated," he said.
