Negri to help in polls campaign

PORT DICKSON, Thurs. - The State Umno will assist the Sabah Barisan Nasional in its campaign for the forthcoming Sabah elections, said State Umno Chief Tan Sri Mohamad Isa Abdul Samad.

He said all seven Umno divisions in the State were preparing for the campaign.

Speaking at his open house in Kampung Baru SiRusa today, Mohamad Isa expressed confidence that BN would be returned to power.

More than 4,000 people visited Mohamad Isa, who is also the Menteri Besar of Negri Sembilan, and his wife Puan Seri Hazizah Tumin at their residence.

Also present were Deputy Education Minister Datuk Khalid Yunus, State Executive Councillors and other senior State officials.
