ALL 36 MIC CENTRAL WORKING COMMITTEE MEMBERS SABAH-BOUND

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 25 (Bernama) -- All the 36 MIC Central Working Committee (CWC) members will be sent to Sabah to help the Barisan Nasional campaign for the state election next month.

MIC president Datuk S.Samy Vellu said the decision was made at the CWC meeting chaired by him, here, today.

"There are 3,400 Indian voters in Sabah and we will make sure that their votes go to BN to continue to rule Sabah, he told a news conference after the meeting. Nominations for the Sabah election have been fixed for March 2 and polling for March 12 and 13.

He said a Sabah MIC Convention would be held on March 7 to be attended by about 1,000 members in the state and opened by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

He also said that the Cabinet had directed that a study be conducted on the move by the National Land Finance Cooperative Society, which has 16 plantations, to pay its estate workers monthly wages since January.

The cooperative's success would be used as the basis to push for plantation companies to pay their workers monthly wages, he said.
