NO DATE FIXED FOR FORMATION OF NEW KEDAH GOVT

ALOR SETAR, Nov 30 (Bernama) -- No date has been fixed for the formation of the new Kedah state government, Menteri Besar Tan Sri Sanusi Junid said today.

Speaking to reporters at his office here, Sanusi said he had yet to have an audience with the Sultan of Kedah and discuss with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad over the issue.

The Sultan is abroad at the moment.

In the 10th general election, the Barisan Nasional (BN) won 24 out of the 36-seat Kedah State legislative Assembly, allowing it to form the new state government with a simple majority.

The rest of the state seats were won by PAS.

PAS also won eight of the 15 parliamentary constituencies in Kedah with seven going to the BN.
