`No extraordinary agenda on Tuesday's Wanita meeting'

SEREMBAN, Sat. - Wanita Umno chief Datuk Dr Siti Zaharah Sulaiman said the movement's executive council meeting next Tuesday does not have any extraordinary agenda.

Siti Zaharah said the meeting will adhere closely with the wishes and advice of Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to work together in the spirit of togetherness to prepare for the coming general election.

She said: "It is going to be like any other working meeting but we will have discussions relating to certain sensitive matters which will not be brought out.

"The discussion of such sensitive matters based on feedback that we have got, is for our privilege and is aimed at gearing up our machinery."

Siti Zaharah, who was speaking to reporters after officiating at an excellence awards presentation ceremony at the Tunjku Khursiah College today, said: "We all understand that the rule of the game is that we have to prepare very well for the election and put everything else behind.

"We have to be more committed, make sure our work plans are clear and our duties are carried out judiciously and responsibly."

Siti Zaharah, who said there was no need to discuss the recent issue (over her announcement to reshuffle the Wanita Umno leadership and subsequent retraction of it), stressed members should not be seen as working against each other and should be united to face the coming election.
