No reasons to oppose BN, says Osu

KOTA KINABALU, Mon. - Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's speech at the Barisan Nasional's 25th anniversary celebrations last night had left supporters of the opposition parties wondering what they were doing opposing the Government.

The Prime Minister's speech televised live from the National Stadium in Bukit Jalil called on opposition parties and their leaders to give up their futile struggles as they could not bring benefit to the country.

Sabah BN head Datuk Seri Osu Sukam, who is also Chief Minister, today said opposition leaders and their supporters were now searching for reasons that compelled them to stay put against the Government.

"Only the blind or those who pretended to be blind do not see what the BN Government has done for the country compared to other foreign countries."

He said this when asked to comment on Dr Mahathir's speech.
