RMX-4 EXPECTED TO BE BUILT IN JANUARY

LANGKAWI, Dec 5 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian experimental aircraft society will build the "Rakan Muda Eksperimen" (RMX-4) plane in January next year if it receives the allocations for it.

Its honorary secretary Mej (Rtd) Abdul Razak Omar said about RM2 million was needed to construct the light aircraft.

"This includes the cost for its spare parts, maintenance, tests and development," he told Bernama.

Yesterday Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad viewed the RMX-4 model displayed at the Langkawi International Maritime and Aerospace Exhibition (Lima) here.

Abdul Razak said initially, RM200,000 was needed to get the project off the ground.
