OPPOSITION PUTTING UP POSTERS AT PROHIBITED PLACES

SETIU, Nov 15 (Bernama) -- The opposition has breached rules laid out by local authorities by putting up posters at prohibited places, State Umno liaison committee secretary Datuk Tengku Mahmud Mansor said today.

He said political parties should only start putting their posters and flags after the nomination day for the 10th general election on Nov 20.

Instead the opposition especially PAS had jumped the gun and started flying their flags and posters right after the Parliament and state legislative assemblies were dissolved last Thursday, he told reporters here.

He said there were complaints that the opposition had pasted posters in the compound of government offices.

"This should not have happened as they should respect government agencies and not involve them with their party activities," he said.

Asked on the state Umno candidates' lineup for the general election, Tengku Mahmud said the list would be submitted to party president Dauk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad by Wednesday.

"The state Umno liaison committee have received the candidates' list from all divisions and it had been studied at the committee meeting last Friday," he said.
