PARLIAMENT: TWO PRIVATISED PROJECTS GIVEN TO PM'S SONS

KUALA LUMPUR, May 5 (Bernama) -- Two projects were privatised and given to Mirzan and Mokhzani, sons of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Deputy Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Fauzi Abdul Rahman said one of the projects was the acquisition of 51 per cent equity in Perbadanan Nasional Shipping Line Bhd (PNSL) by Konsortium Perkapalan Bhd from PERNAS at the cost of RM103.78 million.

Mirzan Mahathir owns 49.49 per cent equity in Konsortium Perkapalan, he said in a written reply to Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim (Bebas-Permatang Pauh) in the Dewan Rakyat today.

Anwar in his question asked the Prime Minister to state the number and cost of privatised projects given to companies owned by his children.

Fauzi said the other project was the privatisation of hospital support services for the Southern Region which was given to Tongkah Medinvest Sdn Bhd.

Mokhzani Mahathir owns 13.19 per cent equity in Tongkah Holdings Berhad which holds 51 per cent equity in Tongkah Medinvest Sdn Bhd, he said.
