Pas admits to character assassinations

PADANG BESAR, Sun. - A Pas leader has admitted that the party is resorting to a tactic of running down the character of their political opponents in their efforts to highlight the "wrongdoings" of the country's leadership.

Pas central committee member Dr Lo Lo Ghazali said there was nothing wrong in making adverse comments about those who had committed wrongdoings.

"They (non-Pas members) said Pas' ceramah is a place where we say bad things about others (mengata orang). It is true, we do say bad things about other people. We can't say bad things about cows. If we need to say bad things about people, then we have to talk about people who had done wrong.

"All the bad things we had said were directed at the country's leaders who had committed wrongdoings so that the people will not elect them to power any more."

Dr Lo Lo, who was speaking at a Pas cheramah in Beseri last night, said it was the duty of the party's leadership to expose the country's "tyrannical and hypocritical" leaders to avert "Allah's wrath from befalling upon the people."

She alleged that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's son could monopolise the country's medical services through the plan to privatise Government hospitals.
