PAS DOES NOT FEAR BN JUGGERNAUT

ALOR SETAR, Nov 15 (Bernama) -- PAS does not fear the Barisan Nasional's move to focus the 10th General Election campaign on Kedah, Perlis, Terengganu and Kelantan, its President Datuk Fadzil Noor said today.

PAS was fully prepared to face the BN salvo in the four states and elsewhere in the country, he told reporters here.

"As you can see there is no panic on our part. We are working as usual and will face them in the four states just like we are facing them in the other states," he said.

He was commenting on the announcement by BN Chairman Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad yesterday that the BN campaign in this election would focus on the four states whose populations were nearly all Malay.

In view of the BN's intended move, Fadzil urged everyone to ensure that a climate of goodwill prevailed during the campaign period.

Nomination is on Nov 20 and polling has been scheduled for Nov 29.

Asked about the allocation of seats among PAS, the DAP, PRM and Keadilan, he said some minor issues were still left to be settled.

"We will settle these matters in a day or two and the final decision will be announced on Nov 19, the eve of nomination," he added.

The leaders of the so called Alternative Front had been meeting in Kuala Lumpur over the past few days discussing seat allocation.
