PJ residents want Vincent Lim to run

PETALING JAYA, Sun. - Representatives of 11 residents' associations and rukun tetangga in the Petaling Jaya Utara parliamentary area are disappointed that incumbent Vincent Lim Kuo Phau has been dropped as a candidate in the general election.

They said Lim had worked hard for the community and have appealed to the Barisan Nasional and MCA leadership to reconsider the decision.

"We appreciate what he has done for the residents of Petaling Jaya Utara," the president of the Damansara Jaya Residents' Association Wong Kah Yew told a Press conference today.

Last Wednesday, MCA president Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik said MCA would field Chew Mei Fun for the Petaling Jaya Utara seat.

Wong said the heads of the 11 associations had sent a petition to BN chairman Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad urging him not to drop Lim. The petition was also carbon-copied to Dr Ling.

Those who signed the petition were from Damansara Jaya, Damansara Utama, Taman Mayang, Taman SEA, SS2, SS20 and SS25A.
