Prime Minister to visit Perak on Monday

IPOH, Wed. - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's two-day visit to Perak from Monday will involve meetings with State Umno officials, Barisan Nasional party leaders and heads of Government departments.

He will also address a meet-the-people gathering at Stadium Perak.

Dr Mahathir will have closed-door meetings with the State Umno liaison committee at 9am on Monday at Menteri Besar Tan Sri Ramli Ngah Talib's residence.

This will be followed by another closed-door meeting with State Umno divisional, Youth and Women's wings leaders at the Town hall.

The Prime Minister will then adjourn for lunch to the State Secretariat with about 1,500 people attending, comprising leaders of BN component parties, heads of departments at both federal and State levels, and leaders of voluntary organisations.

At 2.45pm, Dr Mahathir will attend another closed-door meeting with State BN leaders at the Town hall followed by the gathering at Stadium Perak at 8pm.

Meanwhile, the Prime Minister's wife, Datuk Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali, will have her own itinerary, visiting the Baiduri Reading corner and recreation park at the Ipoh Hospital at 9am.

On Tuesday, Dr Mahathir and Dr Siti Hasmah will visit the low-cost housing project site at Taman Bercham Raya before leaving for Kuala Lumpur.
