Residents to submit memo against toll

A MEMORANDUM containing 22,775 signatures collected during a two-month campaign against the proposed Sprint Damansara Toll will be submitted to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad or Works Minister Datuk Seri S. Samy Vellu.

The campaign was initiated by the Action Committee of Residents' Association, Business Committee and Rukun Tetangga with the co-operation of the Pro-tem Committee Against Sprint Damansara Toll.

The committee was formed to look into the problems arising from the Sprint Damansara Link which is under way.

Committee chairman Yue Sau Him, who is also the Damansara Utama Residents & Owners Association chairman, said about 70 per cent of the signatures collected were from the Pro-tem Committee Against Sprint Damansara Toll, Taman Tun Dr Ismail Residents Association and the Bandar Utama Residents Association.

Yue, at a joint Press conference attended by the MPs of Petaling Jaya Utara Vincent Lim, Petaling Jaya Selatan Donald Lim and Segambut Dr Tan Kee Kwong, said all the signatories were not in favour of the proposed toll.
