SABAH: BN PARTIES AGREE TO SUPPORT WHOEVER IS CHOSEN TO CONTEST

TAWAU, Feb 16 (Bernama) -- Sabah Barisan Nasional does not face any problem with regard to the choice of candidates for the coming state election with all component parties pledging cooperation, state BN chairman Tan Sri Bernard Dompok said today.

He said the component parties had agreed to support whoever was selected to represent the BN in any constituency.

What was needed now, he said, was for all BN members to work hard to ensure the coalition was returned to power.

Dompok, who is the Chief Minister, was speaking to reporters at the Sabah Progressive Party's (SAPP) Chinese New Year open house here.

He said the BN was fully prepared for the state polls and was just awaiting Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's signal on the dissolution of the State Legislative Assembly.

The current five-year term of the assembly expires on March 18.
