SABAH: PAS AIMS TO BE EFFECTIVE OPPOSITION

SANDAKAN, March 9 (Bernama) -- PAS aims to be an effective opposition in the Sabah State Legislative Assembly if it wins all the six seats it is contesting in the ninth state election on Friday and Saturday.

PAS president Datuk Fadzil Noor told reporters on his arrival here today to campaign for the PAS candidates that an effective opposition would ensure there is no abuse of power by the state government in carrying out its duties.

He said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad himself had once said Kelantan needed an opposition when PAS and its allies in Angkatan Perpaduan Ummah won all the Kelantan state seats in an election.

He said PAS was confident of winning in all six constituencies it is contesting as he claimed that there was an increase in support for the party.

PAS has six candidates contesting in the Sabah state election - Ustaz Ridwan Baharun (Sukau), Abdurahman Ahmad (Merotai), Abdul Wahid Yemang (Kalabakan), Mohd Aminuddin Aling (Tempasuk), Yahya Kassim (Likas) and Hamzah Abdullah (Sekong).
