SANUSI: REMEMBER BN'S GOOD DEEDS FOR NATION, PEOPLE

YAN, Oct 21 (Bernama) -- Menteri Besar Tan Sri Sanusi Junid today called on the people to remember the good deeds of the Barisan Nasional (BN) government for the country.

He said the government should be given the credit for the facilities available in the country and the peaceful and comfortable living enjoyed by the people.

"If we require oxygen to live, the people have the right to inhale clean air without having to be thankful to the government.

"But if we are leading a comfortable life, having land and a house in land schemes such as FELDA, it is not our right but a gift from the government. We must be grateful to the government for providing the facilities," he said.

Sanusi was speaking at the leader-with-farm entrepreneurs gathering attended by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad at Batu 17 Secondary School, Sedaka, here.

Sanusi reminded civil servants who often condemned the government to be thankful for being given the opportunity to work for the government.

"If we work for a company and condemn the company's products, surely we will be regarded disloyal to the firm," he said.

Similarly, government employees must show total loyalty and value the good deeds of their employer, he added.
