SENATE: PLOTTERS AGAINST PM UNIDENTIFIED YET

KUALA LUMPUR, May 18 (Bernama) -- Police have yet to identify plotters behind the circulation of tape-recordings inciting the people to assassinate Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, the Dewan Negara was told during question time today.

So far investigations showed that a copy of such recordings was discovered in an envelope addressed to a school in Kelantan last November, Deputy Home Minister Datuk Abdul Kadir Sheikh Fadzir told the House.

"A district chief in Kelantan also received a similar tape recording through the mail last October," he said replying to Senator Datuk Kasim Mh Yusop.

Police were also trying to identify voices in the recording and had taken down statements from several people who could help in investigations conducted under Section 4 (1)(c) of the Sedition Act 1948.

"Police are also identifying those involved in the production and distribution of the tape recordings," he added
