SNAP sticking to its list

KUCHING, Tues. - The Sarawak National Party will stick to its list of candidates so long as Barisan Nasional chairman and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad has no objection.

"Our list of candidates was approved by the party's central executive committee and I don't see any need to change it," its secretary-general Justine Jinggut said today.

He denied speculation that the party has decided to drop treasurer-general Datuk Tiong King Sing and Dr Tiki Lafe.

"As far as SNAP is concerned, Datuk Tiong is our candidate for Bintulu and Dr Tiki in Mas Gading," he said, adding he was aware of certain disgruntled groups which had been spreading lies about the two.
