Cuepacs-Circular

SOME DEPT HEADS HIDE CIRUCLARS FROM STAFF, SAYS CUEPACS

KUALA TERENGGANU, May 6 (Bernama) -- Cuepacs president N. Siva Subramaniam claimed today that there are heads of government department who hide Public Service Department circulars from their staff.

He said Cuepacs had received many complaints on the matter and described it as an unhealthy development that could hamper improvement of the work quality of civil servants.

"If this continues, it will be a big loss to civil servants and can cause misconception among them of the system implemented by the government," he told reporters here today.

He said every directive from the government should be displayed to all its servants to ensure that they discharged their duties according to the set guidelines.

He said the Chief Secretary to the Government, Tan Sri Abdul Halim Ali, was informed of the matter at a meeting with Cuepacs leaders recently.

Siva Subramaniam also said that the Cuepacs working committee would meet soon to discuss several matters to be included in a memorandum on the civil servants' needs which would be presented to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.
