SPECIAL MIC PANEL TO RESOLVE PROBLEMS SPEEDILY

SUNGAI SIPUT, Aug 8 (Bernama) -- The MIC has set up a special panel to resolve problems in the various areas represented by the party, its president Datuk Seri S.Samy Vellu said today.

The MIC had obtained feedback on its position and that of the BN in such areas and a detailed report on its standing was obtained yesterday, he said after opening a two-day motivation seminar for Sungai Siput Wanita Umno members at Telekuk Training Camp about 26KM from here.

On top of this a questionnaire would be sent to all MIC Division heads to enable them to obtain more feedback from the people in their respective divisions, he said.

He said this was to strengthen the MIC election machinery in facing the general election to be held soon.

Samy Vellu also denied rumours spread by opposition parties that he had visited India to see soothsayers on the question of political leadership in this country.

Samy Vellu said he was in India to secure projects worth more than RM1 billion for Malaysian contractors unlike opposition figures who went overseas on "makang angin" trips and to secure funds for their parties.

He said in looking for candidates to lead the country it was no use depending on soothsayers as they could be found based on the services rendered, efforts made and development that had been achieved -- a leader like Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.
