Stop `dirty tactics,' says Opposition

KUALA LUMPUR, Tues. - A joint statement by several Opposition parties today called on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to stop his "dirty tactics" against Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

The statement was signed by Parti Keadilan Nasional president Datin Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail, Pas president Datuk Fadzil Noor, PRM president Dr Syed Husin Ali and DAP secretary-general Lim Kit Siang.

The statement said Dr Mahathir should not wait until the campaign for election to start and then bring out an incomplete and partial list of "alleged cronies." They were referring to Dr Mahathir's allegation that Anwar's crony had amassed RM230 million.

"We call on Dr Mahathir to name Anwar's alleged crony immediately, disclose the wealth owned by him (Dr Mahathir), his family and get all ministers and their families to disclose their wealth."
