`The numbers are good'

KUALA LUMPUR, Fri. - The outcome of this year's general election is a subject of intense debate these days, but for one local fortune teller, the answer is in the stars.

According to feng shui expert Dr Rev Yong, if you add up the numbers in the dates for the dissolution of Parliament (Nov 11), nominations (Nov 20) and polls (Nov 29), you get the numerological value of two.

"Number two is a very auspicious number and has always been significantly used by (Prime Minister and BN chairman) Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad," Yong said in a Press statement.

"With that, I strongly believe and predict that the ruling party will secure a two-thirds majority during the coming election."

Yong had earlier predicted that Dr Mahathir would call for polls either in September or November, as both months were auspicious for the Prime Minister.
