`Pas cannot be trusted to fulfil polls promises'

MUAR, Tues. - It is ridiculous of Pas to aspire to form the next Federal Government when it cannot even fulfil its 1990 election promises to the people of Kelantan.

Kelantan Umno deputy chief Datuk Annuar Musa said voters should judge for themselves if Pas and other opposition parties such as the DAP, Parti Keadilan and Parti Rakyat Malaysia were worthy of support.

"Pas ruled Kelantan for 10 years, but until today, it cannot even fulfil its 1990 election promises. How can we trust such a party to lead Malaysia to greater heights," he said when launching Community Development Day celebrations in Kampung Parit Pinang Seribu.

Annuar, who is also Rural Development Minister, said Pas leaders in a desperate bid to win the election were resorting to slandering Barisan Nasional leaders, including Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

He said Pas and other opposition parties were out to poison the minds of voters to hate the BN Government and Dr Mahathir.

"The economic and political stability, peace and prosperity, unity and harmony that Malaysians now enjoy are not achieved by accident.

"They are the results of hard work, meticulous planning and strategic development policies of the BN Government," he said.

He said the opposition's tactics were aimed at gaining political mileage, adding that the hate campaign was another form of colonisation.
