UNDERGRADUATES TO HAVE DISCOURSE WITH MAHATHIR TOMORROW

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 8 (Bernama) -- More than 4,000 undergraduates from 15 public and private universities will attend a dialogue with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad at Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM) in Bangi near here tomorrow afternoon.

UKM's public relations division acting head Teh Raqamah Abdullah said today the undergraduates would gather at UKM's Dewan Canselor Tun Abdul Razak at 2.30 pm for the discourse with the prime minister.

The prime minister's wife Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohamad Ali, Education Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, UKM Vice-Chancellor Prof Datuk Dr Anuwar Ali and his deputies, faculty deans and senior officers would also attend the function, she said in a statement.

She said the prime minister is scheduled to spend an entire day at the university and to start his itinerary by opening the UKM-MTDC smart technology centre in the morning.

The centre, among other things, would provide consultancy services in biotechnology and in the development of business, management and technical technologies.

The prime minister is scheduled to witness the signing of eight memorandums of understanding between UKM and companies on research undertakings.
