UMNO GENERAL ASSEMBLY ENDS TODAY

KUALA LUMPUR, June 20 (Bernama) -- The 53rd Umno general assembly entered its final day today with the morning segment set aside for delegates to continue debating the motion relating to social and religious issues.

Three more delegates were slotted to debate the motion before the assembly move on to debate the motion on economy and education.

Altogether 2,034 delegates are attending the assembly at the Merdeka Hall of the Putra World Trade Centre (PWTC) here.

The assembly, which began Thursday, approved the motion on the presidential address yesterday.

Prime Minister and party president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and Supreme Council members will wind up debate later today.
