UMNO YOUTH TEAM LEAVES FOR KOSOVO

KUALA TERENGGANU, June 21 (Bernama) -- A group of 10 Umno Youth members, including several doctors, left for Kosovo last night on a humanitarian mission.

Umno Youth international affairs council secretariat head Tengku Zainuddin Tengku Zahid said the group, led by the council's deputy chairman, Dr Shamsul Anuar, was expected to be there for two weeks.

It brought along medical supplies worth RM50,000 for distribution to the refugees, he told Bernama, here, today.

He said the mission was supported by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad who wanted Umno Youth members to see for themselves the sufferings of the Muslims in Kosovo.

During the visit, Umno Youth would film the situation there for screening to Malaysians.
