WE'LL BRIEF THE PM ON "EVERYTHING ABOUT SABAH," SAYS DOMPOK

KOTA KINABALU, Jan 15 (Bernama) -- Chief Minister Tan Sri Bernard Dompok said today the governing Barisan Nasional (BN) coalition will make the most of tomorrow's meeting with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to discuss matters concerning Sabah, including the imminent state election.

"We will brief Dr Mahathir on everything about Sabah and on whatever is required," he said.

He was responding to reporters' question whether the meeting, to be attended by all representatives of the nine-member Sabah BN, would be focussed on the impending state election.

Dompok earlier presented cattle to the police force at the Penampang Police Station, near here, in conjunction with the Hari Raya celebration.

On whether the date for the state election, the ninth for Sabah, had been fixed, Dompok said: "You just have to wait."

The current term of the 48-member State Legislative Assembly ends on March 18.
