Wan Azizah-Kubang Pasu

WAN AZIZAH MAY CONTEST IN KUBANG PASU

JITRA, Feb 26 (Bernama) -- Datin Seri Dr Wan Azizah Ismail has not dismissed the possibility of her contesting the Kubang Pasu parliamentary seat in the next general election.

"Regarding where I'll contest....if Kubang Pasu people want me to contest in Kubang Pasu, what's wrong with that?

"This, the electorate will decide," said wife of the former deputy prime minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim at a talk at the PAS headquarters in Kampung Tok Kesop here last night which thousands of people attended.

The Kubang Pasu parliamentary constituency is presently represented by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Speaking to reporters later, Wan Azizah elaborated that the question of her contesting there was only a possibility.

When asked on what ticket would she be contesting, Wan Azizah said: "That's a secret."

Wan Azizah is not known to be a member of any political party but heads the social justice movement, Adil.

PAS president Datuk Fadzil Noor when approached by reporters on the matter, said PAS would support Wan Azizah wherever she chose to contest.

"She's free to contest on any ticket. Should she contest in Kubang Pasu, PAS will not field a candidate there," he said.

In her speech Wan Azizah spoke of, among other things, her husband's arrest, injuries inflicted on him while in police custody and Anwar's contributions to the nation when he was in the Cabinet.

Former Negeri Sembilan Umno Youth chief Ruslan Kassim also addressed the gathering.
