# Dr M, Brunei Sultan hold talks

**BANDAR SERI BEGAWAN, Sun:** Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad arrived here today for a two-day visit to Brunei. Dr Mahathir and wife, Datuk Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohamed Ali, who flew in from Hong Kong, landed at Brunei International Airport at 11.45am.

The Prime Minister and his entourage were met on arrival by Brunei's Industrial and Primary Resources Minister Datuk Seri Setia Awang Abdul Rahman Mohamad Taib, who is also the minister-in-attendance.

Shortly after his arrival, the Prime Minister addressed about 300 Malaysians residing in Brunei at a luncheon at the Empire Hotel and

Country Resort in Jerudong, about 20km from Bandar Seri Begawan. Among those who attended were lawyers, businessmen, teachers, and university students.

After lunch, Dr Mahathir paid a courtesy call on Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah at the Istana Nurul Iman. He went for horse riding in the evening at the Jerudong Polo Club.

Dr Mahathir then had a meeting with the Sultan where they discussed matters of bilateral interests. He is scheduled to return to Kuala Lumpur tomorrow.

There are an estimated 23,000 Malaysians living and working in Brunei.
