

# PM to open Malaysia Inc summit July 24

KUALA LUMPUR, Fri — Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will open the Malaysia Incorporated Summit at Hotel Istana and deliver his keynote address on July 24.

The two-day summit, which is expected to draw 400 business leaders and senior Government officials, is to assess the effectiveness of Government and private sector partnership.

It is organised by the Asian Strategy and Leadership Institute (Ash) and the Malaysian Administrative Modernisation and Planning Unit.

Asli director and organising committee chairman Datuk Michael Yeoh said he hoped the summit would dispel misconceptions about Malaysia Inc while looking at how it could help sustain economic prosperity.

“It is also a timely opportunity for the private sector to be updated on new Government policies while providing feedback to authorities.”

Two dialogue sessions will be held to allow participants to obtain first-hand information from the Prime Minister and six Cabinet Ministers.

They are Transport Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik; Works Minister Datuk Seri S. Samy Vellu; Primary Industries Minister Datuk Seri Dr Lim Keng Yaik; Energy, Communications and Multimedia Minister Datuk Leo Moggie; Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin and Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Rais Yatim.
