

# Nor Mohd appointed special adviser to PM

**KUALA LUMPUR**, Wed: Bank Negara adviser Datuk Nor Mohamed **Yakcop** has been appointed special adviser to the Prime Minister.

He will advise Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on financial affairs, especially relating to the duties of the executive committee of the

National Economic Action Council. **SUN 11-5-2000** been appointed deputy governor. This is the first time

that the job is shared. No reasons were given.
