

Proceeds of Kenari sales go to Bakti

KUALA LUMPUR, Wed: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today received a total of RM474,000 in donations for Bakti, the organisation of wives of ministers and deputy ministers, to be distributed to various charitable organisations.

The money is from the special sale of three Perodua Kenaris to Daihatsu Motor Company of Japan (RM100,000); the Perodua Vendor's Club (RM152,000), Perodua Distributors (RM120,000) and Berjaya Group executive director Robin Tan who purchased a Kenari through an auction for RM102,000.

Tan later donated his vehicle to Bakti, while Daihatsu donated its Kenari to the Kiwanis Downs Syndrome Association.

The Perodua Vendors Club gave away its Kenari to the Selangor and Federal Territory Association for the Severely Mentally Handicapped, while Perodua Distributors donated its purchase to the International Islamic University to be used for its *Kembara Rakan Muda 2006* programme.
