33 MORE UMNO DIVISIONS TO HOLD MEETINGS DURING WEEKEND

KUALA LUMPUR, March 8 (Bernama) -- Another 33 Umno divisions will hold their respective meeting over the weekend.

Six divisions, namely Peringat, Jeli and Kuala Krai in Kelantan, Libaran and Kinabatangan in Sabah and Padang Terap in Kedah will have their meetings on Saturday, March 11.

The Tanah Merah Umno division will meet on Friday.

The Umno divisions holding their meetings on Sunday are Padang Besar (Perlis), Pokok Sena (Kedah), Tanjung, Bagan, Bukit Mertajam (Pulau Pinang), Ipoh Barat, Kampar, Beruas, Tapah, Teluk Intan and Bagan Datoh (Perak), Seputeh (K.Lumpur), Kuala Selangor, Subang, Ampang Jaya, Tanjung Karang, Kuala Langat, Sepang and Selayang (Selangor).

The others are Selandar, Kota Melaka and Alor Gajah (Melaka), Rasah, Seremban (Negeri Sembilan), Tuaran, Keningau and Semporna (Sabah).

The Umno divisional meetings to be held between March 1 and April 2 involves 165 divisions.

So far, 17 Umno divisions have already held their meetings.

The first to hold the meeting on March 2 was the Tawau Umno division which nominated Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad as party president and Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi as deputy president for the Umno election on May 11.

Other Umno divisions which had held their meetings were Tasik Glugor, Jelutong (Pulau Pinang), Gerik, Batu Gajah (Perak), Cheras (K.Lumpur), Batu Berendam (Melaka), Ledang, Sg. Benut, Senai, Segamat, Tenggara (Johor), Bandau, Penampang, Papar, Sipitang (Sabah) and Sik (Kedah).

All 17 Umno divisions which had held their meetings had nominated Dr Mahathir as party president and Abdullah as deputy president.
