400 visit PM's complex daily

PUTRAJAYA, Fri. - The Seri Perdana Putrajaya Complex which houses the official residence of the Prime Minister has received 13,598 visitors since it was opened to the public on March 23.

Complex coordinator Shaarani Abdul Rahman said support from the public had been overwhelming with at least 400 people visiting the complex daily.

"The official residence of Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad occupies one of the three sections in the complex. The other two sections are the Banquet and Protocol blocks," he said during a media tour of the complex today.

He said the Banquet and Protocol blocks were used when welcoming foreign dignitaries while the Residential Block, which was not open to visitors, was where the Prime Minister lived.

Contrary to claims made by the Opposition, the complex was actually a national pride, he said.
