Amend MAYC rules, says Zahid

KUALA LUMPUR, Tues. - To ensure that organisations like the Malaysian Association of Youth Clubs remain relevant to the younger generation, their constitutions should be amended to ensure only those below 40 can lead them.

Datuk Ahmad Zahid Hamidi, who is standing as a candidate for the MAYC deputy president's post, said there should be a "complete overhaul" of the MAYC constitution and regulations.

He said this was in line with the Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's advice that the association should be led by someone below 40.

This, he said, was necessary to ensure that it could keep up with the aspirations of the younger generation.

"It is only right for the MAYC, which have more than 1,000 affiliates of youth associations, to look into this matter," he told reporters at the Parliament lobby today.

Yesterday, Dr Mahathir was asked to comment on the matter.
