Complaints on allocation of university courses

KUALA LUMPUR, Sat. - MIC president Datuk Seri S. Samy Vellu will brief the Cabinet on complaints from Indian students that they were not given courses they had applied and were qualified for, by Unit Pusat Universiti.

The Works Minister said he would prepare a working paper for the Cabinet on the matter.

He said he had received many complaints from students and parents that some had been given courses that would have no economic value on graduation.

Speaking to reporters after the opening of the MIC general assembly by Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, he said he would discuss the matter with Education Minister Tan Sri Musa Mohamad.

Samy Vellu said the unit should use specific criteria in allocating courses to students.
