Distribution of pamphlets shows desperation

THE distribution of pamphlets at several mosques here by the Opposition during Friday prayers yesterday revealed that it was in a desperate state, Menteri Besar Tan Sri Mohamad Isa Abdul Samad said.

The pamphlets had discredited Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and the BN leadership.

Isa described the act as a low-blow and a desperate last minute attempt to garner support.

"This is a very unscrupulous act by the opposition and the people must be wary of such tactics to spread vicious lies and rumours.

"The act is clearly malicious as it had only carried certain incomplete paragraphs of Dr Mahathir's speech," he said.

He said this opposition tactic was not new as they had in the past also tried to paint a negative picture of various BN leaders.

He said this was also proof that the opposition had no issues to play on, considering that the people in Teluk Kemang were satisfied with the development and progress under BN.

"I am confident the voters will not be swayed by such tactics and will make the right choice," he said.
